# Philippians 1:8-11

"For God is my witness, how I yearn for you all with the affection of Christ Jesus. And it is my prayer that your love may abound more and more, with knowledge and all discernment, so that you may approve what is excellent, and so be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God."

**LITTLE TWIGS:** In our weekly gatherings we engage in teaching God's truth and responding through singing, collective prayer and liturgical readings. We believe it is important for our children to see, hear, and experience God's Word and His people responding in worship. In this way we corporately seek to raise children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord (Eph 6:4), so children remain in worship and teaching with the adults.

Here are a few ideas to engage your little ones in the service today:

- Each week sermon passages are listed in the handout; before church on Sunday read the Scripture being taught out loud as a family and pick out key words in the passage.
- Have your children listen and pat your arm, make a mark, draw a circle, or count the number of times those key words come up in the sermon.
- Incentivize success with rewards or snacks
- Pick up a "Little Twigs" plastic tote in the entry way before church.
- Ask your little one to draw a picture of the things they are hearing in the sermon.
- Have your child help with offering.
- After church take your child to "Little Twigs" where they hear a summary of the sermon, ask them what they learned.

Main Point: The True Meaning of LIFE is seeing Christ formed in others; in aiding their preparation for the day of the LORD.

<u>CONTEXT</u>: The Thessalonians' response to the Gospel—their labor of love, work of faith, and steadfast hope—is living proof that the Gospel is bearing fruit... and this fills Paul with immense joy and gratitude.

- One of the most profound reasons for rejoicing in the Gospel is that it addresses humanity's greatest need: salvation from God's wrath.
- Seeing others rescued and growing in faith is the ultimate fulfillment of life's purpose... = One of THE main ways we glorify GOD

#### 1 Thessalonians 3:1-10:

#### 3:1-2: Sending Timothy Out of Concern

Driven by urgent concern for the Thessalonians' enduring faith under relentless persecution, Paul and his companions
dispatch Timothy. With the clear mission to strengthen and exhort the Thessalonians, ensuring their hope in Christ remains
unwavering and steadfast.

#### 3:3-5: Protecting Faith Amid Affliction

- Paul reminds them that suffering is part of the Christian life
- Paul's concern is the tempter might undermine their faith
- Like with the Galatians, expresses a longing to see "Christ to be formed" (Gal 4:19)

#### 3:6-10: Joy in the Thessalonians' Faith & Thanksgiving

- Timothy's report is great news—proof that the Thessalonians are remaining steadfast in hope.
- Their spiritual progress is life-giving to the Apostles
- Paul's response overflows in thanks (3:9):
- Verse, 10 + 8 is the heart of the passage. Paul's deepest desire is to nurture believers faith, to see Christ fully formed in them. "I will most gladly **spend and be spent** for your souls." (2 Cor 12:15)
- The Gospel is having its full effect; people are being saved from wrath unto righteousness... and there is NOTHING on earth as satisfying as this; loving God and loving your neighbor as yourself!
- The deep longing for good overcoming evil, justice served—is satisfied in Christ, He is the ultimate hero of good vs. evil.

## **Application: Living for Christ Formed in Others**

- Repent of Sin: Are you jealous or resentful at what God is doing in the lives of others?
  - This reveals deficiency, and self-centeredness.
  - We must admit **our sin, rejoice** in the Gospel that saves us from ourselves, **repent** = change mindset & actions.
- 2. Investing in Others' Faith: How are you intentionally building up someone in our church family to help them grow in Christ?
- 3. Joy in Spiritual Growth: How is the spiritual development of others a driving passion in your life?
- **4. Sacrificial Love:** Is the spiritual development of others a driving passion in your life... beyond what is comfortable or familiar?
- **5. Gospel-Driven Encouragement:** How does this **confidence** in the Gospel's power inspire you to take a practical step this week to help someone in our church grow stronger in their trust in Christ?
