JESUS SPEAKING: [Father], I am coming to you, and these things I speak in the world, that they may have my joy fulfilled in themselves. ¹⁴ I have given them your word, and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. ¹⁵ I do not ask that you take them out of the world, but that you keep them from the evil one. ¹⁶ They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. ¹⁷ Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth. ¹⁸ As you sent me into the world, so I have sent them into the world. ¹⁹ And for their sake I consecrate myself, that they also may be sanctified in truth.

"I do not ask for these only, but also for 20 those who will believe in me through their word, ²¹ that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me.²² The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one, ²³ I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me. ²⁴ Father, I desire that they also, whom you have given me, may be with me where I am, to see my glory that you have given me because you loved me before the foundation of the world. ²⁵ O righteous Father, even though the world does not know you, I know you, and these know that you have sent me.²⁶ I made known to them your name, and I will continue to make it known, that the love with which you have loved me may be in them, and I in them "

Ephesians 4:1-16 Vine & Branch Community Church September 11, 2022

The Gospel brings us together in Redemptive Community with God; Eph 2:1-7

The Gospel brings us together in Redemptive Community with each other; Eph 2:13-22

Paul anchors the Ephesians Redemptive Community in the Supremacy of Jesus Christ

Paul Prays to this end (In 3:14); "That according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through His spirit in your inner being..." (17) "So that **Christ may dwell in your [pl.] hearts** through faith..." so the Lord may receive, (21) "To him be **glory** <u>in the church</u> and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations for ever and ever."

(4:1) "*Walk Worthy*." = "Equal weight" - Christians should walk in balance with their **love for Christ on one hand** and their **love for other believers in the other**. = Redemptive Community.

- Balance point 1 (v. 2, 3)
- Balance Point 2 (v. 4-6)

To accomplish this life of balance Christ gifted his church (4:7). "But grace was given to each one of us according to the measure of Christ's gift."

When this gift exchange happens, the church grows.

- Christ gave = Supremacy of Christ
- Apostle, prophets, evangelists, shepherds and teachers give = Minister the Word of Christ
- Equipping the saints for the work of ministry, Church *gives* = **Redemptive Community**

We are God's people, focusing on the **Supremacy of Jesus**, knowing him through **his Word**, experiencing His Love, applying His love to our relationships so that others might know Him, **this is Redemptive Community**!

"So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are **fellow citizens** <u>with the saints</u> and members of the household of God, ²⁰ built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets [word], Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone [Supremacy], ²¹ in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. ²² In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit." = Redemptive Community
