## Pay Close Attention: Hebrews 2:1-4

### February 18, 2023

"Our appreciation of God's Grace can only go as deep as our understanding of our sin goes high."

## What is the Message we have heard?

Jesus is God HIMSELF come to us to make payment for OUR sins; to take our justly earned punishment upon himself, so we could be saved from our own self-created devastation, and live in relationship to Him.

- The "old message" proclaimed by angels was the Mosaic Law (Duet 33:2, Acts 7:53; Gal 3:19)
- This law delivered by angels was "reliable" but it was also "faulty" (Heb 8:7)
- The Law cannot PROVIDE the righteousness that it DEMANDS

Main point from Hebrews: Jesus is superior to the angels who delivered the law of Moses. Jesus' superior to the prophets who delivered the messages of both His judgement and hope of His arrival. Jesus IS the message of the angels; JESUS IS what the prophets predicted. (Heb 1:3)

The Greatest Message Ever Heard: (2:3b):

- 1. **Declared** by the LORD
- 2. **Attested** to by those who heard = the apostles
- 3. Affirmed by God with miracles, signs, and wonders
- 4. **Manifested** through changed lives = Holy Spirit distributing gifts.

"THEREFORE..." because of this (2:1) "We must pay much closer attention to what we have heard, lest we drift away from it." (Pro 3:21)

**HOW WE DRIFT**? (Gen 3:1-3)

"Drift" = ring slipping off a finger, boat drifting from a dock, water that leaks out of a vessel

THE WARNING: "For since the message declared by angels proved to be reliable, and every transgression or disobedience received a just retribution, 3 how shall we escape if we neglect such a great salvation?"

- "Transgression" = every sin of omission (I didn't even know, or think that was a sin)
- "Disobedience" = sin of commission (I knew and did it anyway) blatant sin.

Vs. 3 "How shall we escape if we neglect such a great salvation? Rhetorical... "YOU WON'T" (Rom 6:20-21; Heb 10:26-31)

We need a message of ultimate salvation: It must be greater than law of Moses, greater than our inability to obey ourselves into salvation.

#### PAY MUCH CLOSER ATTENTION:

- 1. We must be clear about what the message is.
- 2. We must not negotiate the Truth to make our lives or the lives of others more comfortable.
- 3. We must be far more attentive to our own sins, than the sins of others.
- 4. Regularly rejoice in the greatest message you have ever heard: Romans 8:33-39
