## Hebrews 4:1 -11

Therefore, while the promise of entering his rest still stands, let us fear lest any of you should seem to have failed to reach it. <sup>2</sup> For good news came to us just as to them, but the message they heard did not benefit them, because they were not united by faith with those who listened. <sup>3</sup> For we who have believed enter that rest, as he has said, "As I swore in my wrath, 'They shall not enter my rest,'' although his works were finished from the foundation of the world.

- <sup>4</sup> For he has somewhere spoken of the seventh day in this way: "And God rested on the seventh day from all his works." <sup>5</sup> And again in this passage he said, "They shall not enter my rest."
- 6 Since therefore it remains for some to enter it, and those who formerly received the good news failed to enter because of disobedience, <sup>7</sup> again he appoints a certain day, "Today," saying through David so long afterward, in the words already quoted, "Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts."
- 8 For if Joshua had given them rest, God would not have spoken of another day later on. 9 So then, there remains a Sabbath rest for the people of God, 10 for whoever has entered God's rest has also rested from his works as God did from his.
- 11 Let us therefore strive to enter that rest, so that no one may fall by the same sort of disobedience. <sup>12</sup> For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. <sup>13</sup> And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

Main Point: "Today if you hear the WORD OF GOD ■ BELIEVE!"

### **Repetitions:**

- The **goal** is entering into **GOD's REST** (4:1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11)
- The means by which we enter is the Hearing the GOOD NEWS (4:2, 11)
- The manner of our entering is **BELIEF** (4:2, 6, 7, 11)
- The <u>timing</u> by which we enter is **TODAY** (3:7, 13, 15, 4:7)
- The <u>resources</u> to maintain believing is **UNITED FAITH WITH FELLOW BELIEVERS** and **HIS WORD** (3:13, 4:2, 4;11)

God's REST = GOD's creation is his DIVINE SANCTUARY in which he dwells/abides with his creation and SHARES his glory/attributes with HIS image bearers; Men & Women Forever. Finishing Work:

- God Finished His Work then rested (4:3-5)
- **Jesus finished His Work** then rested "sat down" (3:14-19)
- Recipients (we) Finish our work then rest (4:11) What is our work? TO BELIEVE THE WORD OF GOD.

Romans 4:2-5 <sup>2</sup> For if Abraham was justified by works, he has something to boast about, but not before God. <sup>3</sup> For what does the Scripture say? "Abraham **believed God**, and it was counted to him as righteousness." <sup>4</sup> Now to the one who works, his wages are not counted as a gift but as his due. <sup>5</sup> And to the one who does not work **but believes** in him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is counted as righteousness."

Two Resources to Help us "Hold fast to our confidence" (3:6; 14)

"Let us therefore strive to enter that rest, so that **no one may fall by the same sort of disobedience** [disbelief to action]. <sup>12</sup> For the **word of God** is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. <sup>13</sup> And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give account."

- 1. United belief with fellow believers (3:12-14; 10:24)
- 2. The Word of God
  - a. In order to maintain our belief we regularly but ourselves before WHAT GOD HAS SAID
  - b. Romans 10:17 "[Belief] comes by hearing and hearing by the WORD OF GOD
