2:1-2. **Devote yourselves to prayer and intercessions and Thanksgivings, toward** the incorruptible truth of the gospel to be effective in the world!

Two reasons this should be our mindset and priority (2-4):

- 1. "That we may lead a peaceable and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way."
- 2. "This is good, and pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, who desires that all people be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth."

When we value what God values and invest in what God invests in TOGETHER = UNITY! (v.5)

- There is one God: The unity of God has the power to change our lives and bring us together
- There is **one Mediator**: There are not many roads to God there is One! Jesus Christ
- There is **one Truth**: v.6 "Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures! (1 Cor 15:3,4)

Timothy's charge:

- 1. Guard the truth that leads to life
- 2. Shepherd and train the men to guard the truth that leads to life.

Vs. 8 The **MEN** should PRAY and lead in prayer with anger or quarreling.

Relevant Cultural Issue: The issues Paul was addressing were specific to Ephesian culture, **Paul's response was TIMELY**. Yet, the **Apostolic answer** that Paul provides is founded upon the **very laws established in the created order**, and therefore it is also be for all Christians, **everywhere**, for **all time**; **Paul's response was TIMELESS**. "Redemption does not cancel out created order, it gives us the ability to fulfil it."

Men should not quibble but lead and live out their place in God's crated order... LIKEWISE (v.9) Women should not be immodest (in dress or authority) but grow in and live out/fulfill their calling in God's created order.

Modesty in Dress:

- 1. Immodesty of clothing in church distracts from the truth inside the church and hinders the reputation of truth outside the church.
- 2. Women professing Godliness should be far more concerned about internal than external adornment (Prv 31:25, 31, Ps 51).
 - the way women can do that is by adorning themselves with good works.

Modesty in Authority:

- 1. "ADORN themselves with character and good works."
- 2. A women is not to teach or proclaim the Scriptures in a way where she exercises authority over men, rather in *regards to teaching the Scripture authoritatively* she should remain quiet.
- 3. Yet she will be saved through childbearing" = "saved" not soul salvation (that is only through Christ) But saved from maligning or distorting truth, confusing the church, and harming gospel impact in the World.
- 4. Women are "saved" through perseverance in their role; joyfully, submissively, contentedly (=quiet), faithfully, lovingly, in holiness living out their unique, valuable, and essential role in God's created order.

APPLICATION:

- 1. Devote yourself to **teaching, studying, and PRAYING** for the effectiveness of the **incorruptible truth** of the Gospel to go out to the world and bring others to Christ and His Kingdom.
- 2. Men, putting away anger or quarreling, lead those around you to sincere prayer
 - Pray with those who Gather with you in your home
- 3. Women, continue to be encouraged, press on, keep going, adorning yourself with character and with good works!
 - Express gratitude and thanks
 - Observe others and imitate
